




Fiction Rothfuss – *The Name of the Wind* (*The Kingkiller Chronicle*) (2008)

The riveting first-person narrative of a young man who grows to be the most notorious magician his world has ever seen. From his childhood in a troupe of traveling players, to years spent as a near-feral orphan in a crime-ridden city, to his daringly brazen yet successful bid to enter a legendary school of magic.

Fiction Liu– *The Grace of Kings* (*The Dandelion Dynasty*) (2015)

Becoming the best of friends after a series of adventures fighting against vast conscripted armies, a bandit and a duke's son become the rival leaders of separate factions with very different ideas about justice and politics.




Fiction Schwab – *A Darker Shade of Magic* (*A Darker Shade of Magic*) (2015)

Kell is one of the last Travelers--magicians with a rare, coveted ability to travel between parallel universes--as such, he can choose where he lands. There's Grey London, dirty and boring. Then there's Red London, where life and magic are revered. White London, ruled by whoever has murdered their way to the throne. And once upon a time, there was Black London...but no one speaks of that now.

Fiction Brown – *Red Rising* (*Red Rising Trilogy*) (2014)

Darrow is a Red, a member of the lowest caste in the color-coded society of the future. Like his fellow Reds, he works all day, believing that he and his people are making the surface of Mars livable for future generations. Yet he spends his life willingly, knowing that his blood and sweat will one day result in a better world for his children. But Darrow and his kind



have been betrayed. Soon he discovers that humanity reached the surface generations ago. Vast cities and sprawling parks spread across the planet. Darrow and Reds like him are nothing more than slaves to a decadent ruling class.


Fiction Johansen – *The Queen of the Tearling* (2014)

On her nineteenth birthday, Princess Kelsea Raleigh Glynn, raised in exile, sets out on a perilous journey back to the castle of her birth to ascend her rightful throne. Plain and serious, a girl who loves books and learning, Kelsea bears little resemblance to her mother, the vain and frivolous Queen Elyssa. But though she may be inexperienced and sheltered, Kelsea is not defenseless: Around her neck hangs the Tearling sapphire, a jewel of immense magical power; and accompanying her is the Queen's Guard, a cadre of brave knights led by the enigmatic and dedicated Lazarus.



Fiction Jemisin - *The Fifth Season* (*The Broken Earth #1*) (2015)

Essun, masquerading as an ordinary schoolteacher in a quiet small town, comes home to find that her husband has brutally murdered their son and kidnapped their daughter. Mighty Sanze, the empire whose innovations have been civilization's bedrock for a thousand years, collapses as its greatest city is destroyed by a madman's vengeance. And worst of all, across the heartland of the world's sole continent, a great red rift has been torn which spews ash enough to darken the sky for years.





Fiction Gaiman – *Trigger Warning: Short Fictions and Disturbances* (2015)

This third collection of short fiction by Gaiman includes previously published pieces of short fiction -- stories, verse, and a very special Doctor Who story that was written for the fiftieth anniversary of the beloved series in 2013 -- as well "Black Dog," a new tale that revisits the world of American Gods.

Fiction Martin – *Rogues* (2014)

Assisting a colleague's search for a missing sister who may be a serial killer's latest victim, criminal psychologist Dr. Charlotte Stone, accompanied by ghost lover Michael, teams up with FBI agents Bartoli and Crane in Las Vegas, where they uncover the murderer's sinister seduction practices.




Fiction Martin – *A Knight of the Seven Kingdoms* (2015)

Taking place nearly a century before the events of *A Game of Thrones*, *A Knight of the Seven Kingdoms* compiles the first three official prequel novellas to George R. R. Martin's ongoing masterwork, *A Song of Ice and Fire*. These never-before-collected adventures recount an age when the Targaryen line still holds the Iron Throne, and the memory of the last dragon has not yet passed from living consciousness.

Fiction King – *The Bazaar of Bad Dreams: Stories* (2015)

There are thrilling connections between stories; themes of morality, the afterlife, guilt, what we would do differently if we could see into the future or correct the mistakes of the past




Fiction Macallister– *The Magicians Lie* (2015)

When a notorious female illusionist uses a fire ax to saw a man in half in front of policeman Virgil Holt, the subsequent discovery of a dead body leads to an interrogation and an unbelievable, spellbinding story.

Fiction Hawkins– *The Library at Mount Char* (2015)

After she and a dozen other children found them being raised by "Father," a cruel man with mysterious powers, Carolyn and her "siblings" begin to think he might be God; so when he dies, they square off against each other to determine who will inherit his library, which they believe holds the power to all Creation



Fiction Novik – *Uprooted* (2015)

A tale inspired by the "Beauty and the Beast" story follows the experiences of Agnieszka, who becomes the latest girl chosen to serve an immortal wizard who protects their village from the malevolent forces of a nearby forest.

Fiction Anders – *All the birds in the sky* (2016)

Childhood friends Patricia Delfine and Laurence Armstead didn't expect to see each other again, after parting ways under mysterious circumstances during middle school. Little do they realize that something bigger than either of them, something begun years ago in their youth, is determined to bring them together to either save the world, or plunge it into a new dark ages.



Fiction Ishiguro – *The Buried Giant* (2015)

The Romans have long since departed, and Britain is steadily declining into ruin. But, at least, the wars that once ravaged the country have ceased. Axl and Beatrice, a couple of elderly Britons, decide that now is the time, finally, for them set off across this troubled land of mist and rain to find the son they have not seen for years, the son they can scarcely remember
