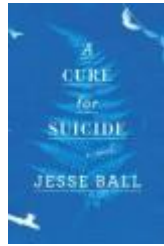


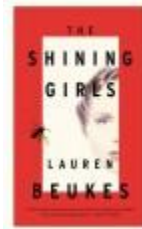

Fiction Ball -- *A Cure for Suicide* (2015)
A man with troubling dreams, known as the “claimant,” is being treated by a woman, his “examiner,” in a small village house until a charismatic but volatile woman interrupts his progress.

Fiction Beukes -- *The Shining Girls* (2013)

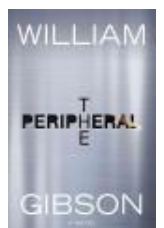
The sole survivor of a time-traveling serial killer who began his murder spree in Depression-era Chicago tries to hunt him down in 1989 along with help from an ex-homicide reporter. Also: *Broken Monsters*



Fiction Bowen – *Wake of Vultures* (2015)
After an encounter with a deadly stranger leads her to discover the source of the mysterious sand in the desert, Nettie Lonesome sets out on a quest to find her true kin--if the monsters along the way don't kill her first.

Fiction Faber -- *The Book of Strange New Things* (2014)

Called to perform missionary work in a world light years away where the natives are fascinated by the concepts he introduces, man of faith Peter Leigh finds his beliefs tested when he learns of natural disasters that are tearing Earth apart.



Fiction Gibson – *The Peripheral* (2014)
Depending on her veteran brother's benefits in a city where jobs outside the drug trade are rare, Flynne assists her brother's latest beta-test tech assignment only to uncover an elaborate murder scheme.

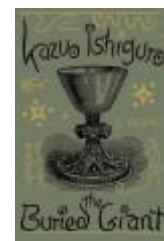
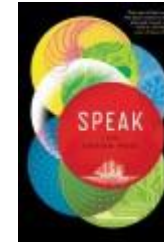
Fiction Grossman – *The Magician's Land* (2014)



Visiting his magical college after being cast out of the secret land of Fillory, Quentin Coldwater, along with brilliant undergraduate Plum, encounters desperate practitioners of gray magic before discovering a sorcery masterwork that could dissolve the boundaries between Fillory and Earth. Also in the series: *The Magicians* and *The Magician King*

Fiction Hall – *Speak* (2015)

Exploring the creation of artificial intelligence and illuminating the very human need for communication, connection and understanding, *Speak* is told from the perspectives of five very different people from different times and places.



Fiction Ishiguro -- *The Buried Giant* (2015)
As the wars that have ravaged Britain fade into the past, Axl and Beatrice, a couple of elderly Britons, set out on a journey to find the son they have not seen in years, and are joined in their travels by a Saxon warrior, his orphaned charge, and a knight.

Fiction Itäranta -- *Memory of Water* (2014)

After global warming changes the world's geography and its politics, and wars are waged over water, 17-year-old Noria Kaitio becomes a tea master, a position that holds great responsibility and great secrets, until her father's death forces her to choose between safety and fighting back.



Fiction Jemisin – *The Fifth Season* (2015)
After the empire Sanze collapses and the vast continent Stillness becomes ravaged by a red rift which darkens the sky, Essun, whose daughter has been kidnapped by her murderous husband, crosses Stillness in a desperate attempt to save her daughter.



Fiction Lepucki – *California* (2014)

After escaping the crumbling ruins of Los Angeles for a shack in the wilderness, Cal and Frida realize they are pregnant and seek refuge in the nearest settlement, a guarded, dark and paranoid community that poses a whole new set of dangers.

Fiction Liu -- *The Grace of Kings* (2015)

Becoming the best of friends after a series of adventures fighting against vast conscripted armies, a bandit and a duke's son become the rival leaders of separate factions with very different ideas about justice and politics.



Fiction North -- *The First Fifteen Lives Of Harry August* (2014)

Forced to relive his life over and over again, Harry August receives a message on his eleventh death bed from a little girl who tells him that the world is about to end, and it is up to him to stop it. Also: *Touch*



Fiction Novik – *Uprooted* (2015)

A tale inspired by the "Beauty and the Beast" story follows the experiences of Agnieszka, who becomes the latest girl chosen to serve an immortal wizard who protects their village from the malevolent forces of a nearby forest.



Fiction Priest – *Maplecroft: The Borden Dispatches* (2014)

Taking up residence in Maplecroft, a mansion near the sea, Lizzie Borden, a suspect in the brutal deaths of her father and stepmother, waits with an axe to stop the evil that is rising from the ocean's depths to consume her.



Fiction Rickert – *The Memory Garden* (2014)

Bay's mother, Nan, has kept lots of secrets from her, and when Nan meets up with her estranged friends Mavis and Ruthie, the secrets just begin to be revealed.

Fiction Stavely – *The Emperor's Blades* (2014)

The children of an assassinated emperor try to stay alive and avenge their father's death while continuing down their individual life-paths, one in a monastery, another training with elite soldiers, and one appointed a minister determined to prove herself to her people.

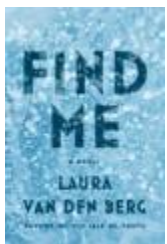
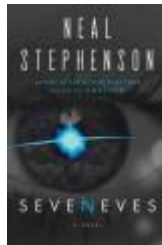


Fiction St. John Mandel – *Station Eleven* (2014)

One snowy night a famous Hollywood actor slumps over and dies onstage during a production of King Lear. Hours later, the world as we know it begins to dissolve.

Fiction Stephenson -- *Seveneves* (2015)

Five thousand years later after a catastrophic event rendered the Earth a ticking time bomb, the progeny of a handful of outer space explorers--seven distinct races now three billion strong--embark on yet another audacious journey: to return to Earth.



Fiction Van Den Berg – *Find Me* (2015)

Joy, a loner who works the graveyard shift at a grocery store, finds herself immune to a strange and fatal virus that is sweeping the United States and sets off across the devastated country in search of her birth mother.



Fiction Weir – *The Martian* (2014)

Stranded on Mars by a dust storm that compromised his space suit and forced his crew to leave him behind, astronaut Watney struggles to survive in spite of minimal supplies and harsh environmental challenges that test his ingenuity in unique ways.
